**Subject:** NERC Ballot - Project 2010-02 Connecting New Facilities to the Grid

NPCC Members of the NERC Registered Ballot Body,

The two standards (FAC-001-2 and FAC-002-2) that are part of the subject project are currently posted for ballot through 8 pm, June 23, 2014. The initial ballot achieved approval and quorum and this ballot is for Final approval.

The RSC reviewed and discussed the standard at our meeting this week. We did not reach a consensus position on a recommended voting position however the majority indicated their member companies would be supporting the standards. The dissenting opinions were based primarily on the following:

- Not results based and simply a standard requiring coordination and procedures.
- FERC has existing Small and Large Interconnection Procedures and NPCC entities that file tariffs already have procedures. This “could” create a “multiple jeopardy” for non-compliance with these previous Orders, Tariffs, and the proposed standard.
- Some members believe this standard is not needed and a P-81 type of standard and mostly market driven and administrative in nature.

NPCC as the Regional Entity does not see a reliability related concern and believes that although there may not be an issue within the regional footprint, there may be some gap in other Regions that would be addressed with the passage of this standard. **NPCC will therefore be voting affirmative.**
