NPCC Members and Entities of the NERC Registered Ballot Body,

The subject standard is posted through 8pm January 17th, 2019. The Regional Standards Committee has reviewed the associated materials which have been posted.

This ballot and proposed revision constitutes the first phase of this project which addresses removal of administrative actions done by NERC as shown in the attachment of the Standard, addressing some findings of the Resource Subcommittee –specifically, inconsistencies in calculation of Interconnection Frequency Response Obligations (IFROs) due to Interconnection Frequency Response performance changes of Point C and/or Value B. These values are the nadir of the frequency dip as a result of some perturbation, and a recovered value of frequency respectively. Also the existing Eastern Interconnection Resource Contingency Protection Criteria is proposed to be replaced with Resource Loss Protection Criteria (RLPC) and corresponding revisions of the Frequency Response Survey form. I am unaware of any issues precluding support and see this as supporting ‘Reliable Operation.’ RSC members have indicated their support for this ballot. NPCC, as the Regional Entity will support the revision to the standard and vote Affirmative on this ballot.
