



NPCC Criteria Compliance and Enforcement Program (CCEP)

The CCEP monitors Full Members of NPCC for compliance on a subset of the regionally specific NPCC Criteria that are unique to the NPCC Bulk Power System.

Through the oversight of NPCC Staff, the stakeholder Compliance Committee (CC) supports the annual implementation of the CCEP via the CCEP-1 *NPCC Criteria Compliance and Enforcement Program (CCEP) Process Document*. A sub-group of CC members develops the annual CCEP Implementation Plan for approval by the full CC and acceptance by the RCC. The full CC reviews the returned certification forms and NPCC staff develops an annual assessment report that summarizes the certification results where any recommendations on non-compliances are then presented to the RCC.

Upon RCC acceptance, instances of noncompliance result in a summary notification from the CC Chair to the Compliance Executive of the offending Full Member and to the NPCC President and CEO.

Under the 2021 and 2022 CCEP Implementation Plans, the following aspects of NPCC Criteria will be monitored. Please see [CCEP Documents](#) for more information.
